Aldaba and UP Law Dean Fides Cordero-Tan signed a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Trade and Industry Competitiveness and Innovation Group (CIG) and the UP Law Center establishing cooperation in the area of eCommerce. The UP Law Center Shall provide the DTI, particularly the eCommerce programme Office with scholarly and technical Assistance in the review of the Philippine Ecommerce Roadmap2016-2020 and the succeeding roadmap.
